Giampiero Bambagioni is an Urban economist, expert in Sustainable finance and ESG evaluation, with extensive experience at both institutional and professional level. Giampiero studies the urban development phenomena at an international level, with focus on the transformation of urban settlements into more liveable and resilient Smart Sustainable Cities (SSC) within the framework of the UN SDGs.

Giampiero is a Bureau Member of the UNECE Committee on Urban Development Housing and Land Management, and Co-Chair of the Smart Sustainable Cities and Innovative Financing Task Group.

Giampiero is Head of Scientific and International Activities, and Chair of the Technical-Scientific Committee of Tecnoborsa Scpa, Rome; and IVSC Europe Board Member (the International Valuation Standards Council is the global standard setter for property and business valuation), London.

He has been cooperating with the UN system since 2001. Former Chair of the UNECE Real Estate Market Advisory Group. In May 2016 he co-organized the Forum in which the “Rome declaration” has been adopted as a basis for the launch of the U4SSC initiative; forum hosted by the Ministry of Economic Development (Italy) promoted in cooperation with UNECE and ITU.

Giampiero has been teaching at University level for many years. He is currently Lecturer of Economic Evaluation of Projects and Real Estate Finance in official and post-graduate courses at Sapienza University of Rome and at the Politecnico di Milano University.

Giampiero, after a Master's degree in Economics, obtained a postgraduate Diploma in “European Public Management and Economic Policy” from Scuola Nazionale dell'Amministrazione - SNA, under the Presidency of the Council of Ministers (Italy); he also attended specialization courses at the University of Milan (la Statale) and at SDA Bocconi, Milan.

Giampiero has published many publications. Under his leadership has been elaborated – with the involvement of an international Task Force – the UNECE Policy Framework for Sustainable Real Estate Markets (2010-2019), UN official publications.
